1 Corinthians 6v12-20

Getting to know you

1. Would you rather: go to an all-inclusive resort for a week or backpacking for a month? Magically always have your laundry done or all your dishes cleaned?
2. With community groups starting this week, how are you feeling, and what are you hoping to experience together over these next 8 weeks?
3. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time, caught your attention, or was your biggest takeaway?

Going deeper

4. Read 1 Corinthians 6v12. What are some of the cultural norms, sayings, and ways that are "lawful" but not "beneficial" for us as Jesus followers?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 6v12-20. Paul's calling the church to wholehearted devotion to Christ: where they serve no other master, are united to no other, and belong to Him alone. What areas do you see Christians serving other masters, being united to other things, or belonging to other ways? Whether big or small, where can you be prone to this as well?
6. Re-read 1 Corinthians 6v18-20. Just because we did a series on sexuality doesn't mean that all of our sins and struggles have gone away! In our hyper-sexualized cultural moment, what does it look like to practically "flee from sexual immorality" and "honor God with our bodies" in all of life?

Pray that we would honor God with our bodies, flee sin, and truly have wholehearted devotion to Jesus in all of life.
